



Invitation for construction workers in affected Local Government Areas to Vaccination Super Sunday

Dear construction worker,

Thank you for the important work you are doing during our response to COVID-19.

We are writing to invite you to a Vaccination Super Sunday (this Sunday 15 August) at the NSW Health Vaccination Centre at Sydney Olympic Park. We'll be opening extended hours from 7.30am – 7pm.

If you live in Blacktown, Canterbury-Bankstown, Cumberland, Fairfield, Georges River, Liverpool, Campbelltown, Paramatta and the suburbs of Caddens, Claremont Meadows, Colyton, Erskine Park, Kemps Creek, Kingswood, Mount Vernon, North St Marys, Orchard Hills, Oxley Park, St Clair and St Marys you are now able to book one of 8,000 priority appointments.

A vaccination is one of the best ways to protect you against COVID-19.

If you are between 16 and 39 years of age you are able to book an appointment for a COMIRNATY™ Pfizer vaccine. You will need two doses of the vaccine at least 8 weeks apart.

If you are over 39 years of age you are able to book an appointment for an AstraZeneca vaccine. You will need two doses of the vaccine 4-6 weeks apart.

The vaccine is free and you do not need a Medicare card to make an appointment. This invitation is only for you and cannot be forwarded on to anyone else.

What you need to do:

To book an appointment use following links:

- **Pfizer appointment booking** - People aged 16-39 years only: bit.ly/mycovaxvc8
- **AstraZeneca appointment booking** - Anyone over 39 years: bit.ly/mycovaxvc1

Then, select the **construction worker** in the drop-down menu.

On the day of your vaccination you will need to bring photo ID as well as proof of your place of work (white card).

You must not attend your vaccination appointment if you have any COVID-19 symptoms. Please get tested and self-isolate until you receive a negative test result. Our Support Centre staff will help you rebook your appointment at another time.
