Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009

Nominations are called for:

- Divisional Branch Council Member – Cumberland Zone (1)

Nominations, which must be in writing and comply with the registered rules of the Organisation, may be made at any time from 08/09/2021.

A nomination form is available for electronic completion on the AEC Portal, www.aec.gov.au/ieb/. However, the nomination form must then be lodged in accordance with the Organisation's rules (see below).

Nomination forms are available on request. Prospective candidates and nominators should verify their financial status and any other qualifications required by the Organisation's rules prior to lodging nominations.

Nominations must reach the Returning Officer via the lodgement method(s) stipulated below **not later than 4:00pm Australian Eastern Standard Time (AEST) on 22/09/2021**.

How to lodge nominations, nominations must be lodged via the following method(s):

By Portal: Australian Electoral Commission Portal, www.aec.gov.au/ieb/

By Email: A properly completed nomination form including all necessary signatures and attachments may be scanned and submitted as a pdf file to IEBnominations@aec.gov.au

PLEASE NOTE:

1. Emails to the AEC inbox that appear to be spam may be blocked. It is the responsibility of senders to ensure that their email reaches the AEC before the deadline for nominations.
2. In order to be able to be received by the AEC, emails should be no greater than 6 MB in size.
3. You may call 03 9285 7129 to enquire about the status of your nomination.

Withdrawing Nominations

Nominations cannot be withdrawn after Australian Eastern Standard Time (AEST) on 29/09/2021.

Candidate Statements

Candidates may submit a statement to be included with ballot material. Divisional Branch Management Committee Members statement may not exceed 200 words for and in respect of Divisional Branch Councillors 50 words. Statements should contain only the candidate's personal history and policy statement. Only statements which comply with the Rules and are received by the Returning Officer by 4:00pm (Australian Eastern Standard Time (AEST)) on 22/09/2021 can be accepted.

Voting Period

The ballot, if required, will open on 13/10/2021 and close at 5:00pm Australian Eastern Standard Time (AEDT) on 10/11/2021.

Scrutineers

Any candidate may appoint a financial member of the union to act as their scrutineer by notification in writing to the Returning Officer. The appointment of scrutineers closes 5:00pm Australian Daylight Savings Time (AEDT) on 10/11/2021. A form is available from the Returning Officer for the purposes of appointing Scrutineers.
